Rules and Regulations

Only two entries per Class number. Article exhibited must be the work of the exhibitor. Exhibits previously entered are not eligible. Where there is no other competition, a premium will be awarded only if the article merits an award. The Superintendent may reclassify entries not entered in the correct Division or Class.

All articles must be clean and well pressed. Stained or soiled articles will be disqualified.

All Home Arts needlework entries will be judged by the following standards:

Cleanliness	15%
Degree of perfection	50%
Amount of work	25%
Suitability of purpose for which it is intended	10%

Items entered must have been made within the last two years and not previously entered in the Western Montana Fair.

Amateur refers to those who do not derive income directly from their craftwork and have had little or no training in it. The amateur generally does the craft for the pleasure involved. Semi-professional refers to income derived from the sale of goods and is less than 50% of their annual income. Professional refers to those whose work is produced primarily for the purpose of selling and more than 50% of their annual income is derived from the sales, or who have a diploma, certificate, degree or three or more years of training in the arts and/or crafts, or teach in the arts or crafts.

All classes are open to men, women, or children.

Classifications: Enter the appropriate sub classification in brackets following the class number. For example, 7005 (2) would indicate that you are a professional exhibitor wishing to enter lot number 7005.

Rules and Regulations

Parent or guardian must sign the entry application if the exhibitor is under age 18. 4-H members are encouraged to enter the Open Class Show. Entry fees apply for 4-H and FFA members.

Judging of halter classes will be held in conjunction with the rules and regulations per breed specifications rule book. Judging of the pleasure and equitation classes will be held in conjunction with the rules and regulations in the USEF Rule Book.

The Superintendent and/or judge reserves the right to cancel any division due to a lack of participation or to split large divisions. If the situation exists, the exhibitor will be notified at the start of the division. The judge's decision is final in all matters relative to the rules and regulations.

Judging will take place on the track in front of the grandstand.

Parking will be allowed in the infield only. Enter on the backside of the track next to the YMCA. At 8:00 a.m., horses and riders may enter the parking area.

We regret that we cannot accommodate you with stalls or overnight parking. **All exhibitors must complete an entry application either ONLINE or at POST TIME. Entries will be accepted until the division**

starts. Online deadline is July 27, 2009. For detailed, step-by-step instructions for the entry system, go to pages 36-37.

Best of Breed Division will be open to those horses placing 1st and 2nd in each class number. Best of Show division will be open to the Best of Breed winners.

Premium money will be paid in each class number, except for the Best of Breed and Best of Show in which a **Roy Rodenberger/John Roberts Memorial Trophy Blanket** will be presented to the winner.

Novice - Not to have won 3 blue ribbons in any show.

A 45-minute lunch break will be taken as close to 12:00 Noon as possible.

Jackpot Western Pleasure: This division will be open to any and all horses. Premium money will not be paid in this Division. There will be a \$5 cash only entry fee to be paid on the day of the Show when you pick up your numbers. 100% of the money will be paid back on a 40-30-20-10 split. This money will be paid at the time of placing.

Ribbons will be awarded to five places in each class.

Absolutely no stallions will be shown by exhibitors under the age of 18.
