**Rules and Regulations**

Parent or guardian must sign the entry application if the exhibitor is under age 18. 4-H members are encouraged to enter the Open Class.

Judging of halter classes will be held in conjunction. with the rules and regulations per breed specifications rule book. Judging of the pleasure and equitation classes will be held in conjunction with the rules and regulations in the USEF Rule Book.

The Superintendent and/or judge reserves the right to cancel any

division due to a lack of participation or to split large divisions. If the situation exists, the exhibitor will be notified at the start of the division. The judge's decision is final in all matters relative to the rules and regulations.

Judging will take place on the track in front of the grandstand.

Parking will be allowed in the infield only. Enter on the backside of the track next to the YMCA. At 8:30 am., horses and riders may enter the parking area.

We regret that we cannot accommodate you with stalls or overnight parking. **All exhibitors must complete an entry application. Entries will be accepted until the division starts. No post entry fee.**

Best of Breed Division will be open to those horses placing 1st and 2nd in each class number. Best of Show division will be open to the Best of Breed winners.

Premium money will be paid in each class number, except for the Best of Breed and Best of Show in which a **Roy Rodenberger/John Roberts Memorial Trophy Blanket** will be presented to the winner.

**Novice** - Not to have won 3 blue ribbons in any show.

A 45-minute lunch break will be taken as close to 12:00 Noon as possible.

**Jackpot Western Pleasure:** This division will be open to any and all horses. Premium money will not be paid in this Division. There will be a \$5 cash only entry fee to be paid on the day of the Show when you pick up your numbers. 100% of the money will be paid back on a 40-30-20-10 split. This money will be paid at the time of placing.

Ribbons will be awarded to five places in each class.

Absolutely no stallions will be shown by exhibitors under the age of 18.

Premium payout for Divisions, except Jackpot Western Pleasure Best of Breed, and Best of Show:

1st Place, \$12.00 - 2nd Place, \$8.00 - 3rd Place, \$4.00

**Premium money will be paid out at the Western Montana Fair Office only on the day of the Horse Show. No premium checks will be mailed.**

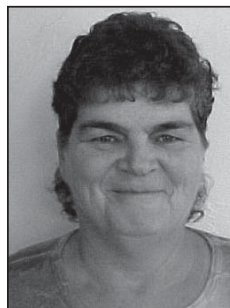

**STALL FEE \$5.00 PER HEAD. All Open Class Livestock Entry Tags must be submitted ONLINE by June 30, 2008.** A Livestock Entry Application is required for each animal you plan to exhibit. Livestock Applications must be submitted through our new Online Exhibit Entry System. Just go to [www.WesternMontanaFair.com](http://www.WesternMontanaFair.com) and click on "Enter Exhibits". If you do not have Internet access, the Fair Office will assist you. Pen placement is on a first come, first served basis, and date and time of online application will serve as official record of application submission time. **In addition to submitting Class Numbers you want to enter, MAKE SURE TO ADD ONE STALL FEE FOR EACH ANIMAL YOU ARE ENTERING.** Parent or guardian must sign entry application if exhibitor is under age 18. There will be an electronic signature box for this verification at the Online Entry System screens. Visa, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover Cards are accepted.
